Continuing Education Nontraditional Student & Summer Session Scholarship Application
SUMMER 2012

Eligibility Requirements

- You must be a nondegree student. Students admitted to degree programs at the University of Colorado Boulder are not eligible for this scholarship.
- You are eligible to receive this scholarship only once. Please note: if you have received a scholarship from Continuing Education in the past you are ineligible to apply.

Award Amount

- Award amount may not exceed 80% of the resident rate of one three-credit course and is subject to funding availability. Awards are decided based on a competitive essay review.

Application and Award Process

- Along with the application, include a typewritten essay of at least 250 words addressing your past educational history; your future goals; and the way in which the scholarship will assist you in meeting those goals.
- Colorado law requires that we verify that students receiving a “benefit” from the State of Colorado are lawfully present in the United States. This scholarship is an example of this type of benefit. You DO NOT need to verify legal presence if you:
 - Have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) in the current or a previous academic term. www.fafsa.ed.gov.
 - Have applied for the College Opportunity Fund in the current or previous academic term at CU-Boulder. <http://cof.college-assist.org>.
 - Have completed the Affidavit for Legal Presence in the US for the current or a previous academic term, either in person or submitted via mail/fax:
http://registrar.colorado.edu/students/pdf/affadavit_verifying_citizenship.pdf.
- Complete applications – including essay and verification of legal presence – will be reviewed by a scholarship committee after the posted deadline.
- Awardees will be notified via the email given on the application.
- Scholarship awards are paid directly to your student bill. You must be enrolled in a course in order to receive a scholarship.
- Withdrawal from the course for which you are awarded the scholarship will result in the cancellation of the scholarship award.
