**Division of Continuing Education and Professional Studies Scholarship
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This Scholarship Program is designed to assist part-time students with the cost of their tuition at the University of Colorado at Boulder's Division of Continuing Education and Professional Studies (CEPS). The scholarship will assist in paying a percentage of your tuition charges for one course taken in the spring 2010 semester. The scholarship is competitive based on the quality and content of your essay.

Eligibility for the Nontraditional Scholarship

- You must be 22 years of age or older.
- Course work must be taken through Continuing Education and Professional Studies (credit or noncredit).
- Students in degree programs at CU Boulder are not eligible for this funding. You must be a non-degree student.
- You must complete the Affidavit For Colorado House Bill 1023
- You are eligible to receive this scholarship only once. **Please note: if you have received a Continuing Education and Professional Studies Scholarship in the past, you are ineligible to apply.**

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS

As previously stated an essay of 250 words or more must be submitted with the application. Please include in the essay your past educational history; your future educational goals; and the way in which the scholarship will assist you in meeting those goals. Upon receipt of your application an acknowledgement will be sent to you via email. Applications and essays must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee by the deadline date stated. Late applications will be considered based on availability of funds. **Students admitted to degree programs at the University of Colorado at Boulder are not eligible for this scholarship.**

Colorado law requires that we verify that students receiving a "benefit" from the state of Colorado are lawfully present in the United States. The Nontraditional Student Scholarship is an example of this kind of benefit. If you have completed a FAFSA (free application for federal student aid) or applied for and are approved to receive the College Opportunity Fund (COF), you have met the requirements of the legislation. If you have not completed a FAFSA or been approved for COF, you will need to complete the attached affidavit and BRING it, in person, along with an approved photo ID (visit [HERE](#) for a list of approved ID options) to 1505 University Ave, Boulder CO, 80309-0178 Monday-Friday 8:00AM-5:00PM. Awarding Process and Disbursement of Scholarship Award

Applications and essays will be reviewed by a six-member scholarship committee. This process will not begin until after the deadline. Award notices will be mailed to the address on the scholarship application. **Scholarship awards are paid directly to your student bill once you are enrolled. *Withdrawal from the class for which you received the scholarship will result in cancellation of the scholarship award.***

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
